Optimal Care Cancer Pathways (OCP)

National guides for lung, colorectal, prostate and gastrooesophageal cancer outline recommended care at each stage.

Lymphoedema in Primary Care*

Hospital referral criteria for patients with chronic lymphoedema, and the pathways for diagnosis and assessment.

Specialist Clinics Reform*

Referral criteria for adult specialist clinics in otolaryngology/Ear, Nose and Throat, vascular surgery and urology. Available on all VIC HealthPathways websites and the South Eastern Melbourne online care pathway website from September 2018.

Real Time Prescription Monitoring - SafeScript

HealthPathways referral pathways to complement the SafeScript system, which shows live updates of medicine supply history of high risk medicines. Access available to doctors, pharmacists, and hospitals.

Paediatric HealthPathways*


29 paediatric pathways on low complexity, high volume conditions faced in general practice. Available on all VIC HealthPathways websites from late-October 2018.

Pathways & Engagement Statistics




