Objective Structured Clinical Exam

This course will assist GPs preparing for the Objective Structured Clinical Exam (OSCE) of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP).

Presenters include

Dr. Kirsten van Haaster is an Australian-trained GP who gained Fellowship of the RACGP in 2003. Kirsten works in an outer metropolitan practice and occasionally works as a GP locum in outback Australia. She has been a RACGP OSCE examiner and supervisor of GP registrars since 2007. Kirsten has been leading OSCE courses for more than four years and her special interests include mental health and Aboriginal health.

Dr. Rashmi Saluja is an International Medical Graduate who has specialist qualifications as both a physician and GP. Rashmi has worked in rural and metropolitan practices in Australia since 2008. Her past roles include Medical Educator for GP Registrars and examiner for the Pre-employment Structured Clinical Interview (PESCI). Rashmi has been a RACGP OSCE examiner for over seven years and is currently a practice principal at an inner city practice.

Attendees will be placed in small groups of no more than seven GPs and will be given the opportunity to practise a variety of exam scenarios with an experienced OSCE examiner and patient role-player. The examiners will provide guidance and feedback for improving exam performance. A mini mock exam is included in the course.
