Learn more about My Health Record

The deadline for Australians to decide if they want a My Health Record or not is midnight on Thursday 31 January 2019.

EMPHN is running two drop-in information sessions for health consumers to ask any questions they may have about My Health Record.

Event details

Every Australian will get a My Health Record in early 2019 unless they tell the government they don't want one.

My Health Record is a secure, online summary that allows GPs and health professionals to see a person's medical information, including recent medical treatments, prescriptions, allergies and immunisations.

You may need information on

- what is in a My Health Record
- how to use My Health Record
- who can see a My Health Record
- how to set up an Authorised Representative
- how you can opt out if you want to
- how to set up privacy and security features
- what the recent MHR legislative changes mean.
