

My Health Record: informing your patients

For practice managers and practice nurses

The Australian Government has legislated that a My Health Record will be created for all Medicare and Department of Veterans' Affairs card holders in Australia by the end of 2018, unless they choose not to have one.

There will be a three-month period commencing 16 July 2018 when consumers can inform the Government of their choice to opt out of the My Health Record system.

Eastern Melbourne Primary Health Network (EMPHN) invites you to a workshop where you will have the opportunity to learn how you can best support your patients in understanding My Health Record and the choice available to them.
