

Ocular Emergencies

Patients can present at general practice with a number of issues that can be classified as emergencies needing urgent care including acute loss of vision, penetrating trauma, chemical injuries and acute red eye. Maintaining ocular status can be hampered by a lack of specialist equipment, however, patient history and basic ocular tests can provide enough information for a practitioner to diagnose and refer.
