

PDSA: Increasing the uploading of Shared Health Summaries to the My Health Record for our patients who have an active Chronic Disease diagnosis.

Having a Shared Health Summary uploaded to the My Health Record will enable better care coordination between providers for people who are experiencing chronic and/or complex conditions. Shared Health Summaries uploaded by all treating healthcare providers give an overview of the timeline and treatment received by the patient.

Having immediate access to information in My Health Record at point of care enables providers to focus on providing the best possible care (especially in an emergency situation).

Increase the number of Shared Health Summaries being uploaded to the My Health Record for patients with chronic diseases.

Idea: All patients with a Chronic Disease attending or having a telehealth appointment for Management Plans/ Health Assessments/ Vaccination appointments have a Shared Health Summary uploaded to the My Health Record.

- Implementing a new process.
- Ensure all clinical staff are trained on using the process of uploading SHS. . (Training is available on the use of My Health Record) at this Link)
- Ensure all staff have access to the My Health Record through the Clinical Information System.
- Educate all practice staff on how and why this is important.
- Track numbers in the EMPHN POLAR Practice Report.

PLAN:

- 1) Organise a staff meeting to discuss ideas and how the practice will be implementing this PDSA and identify if any training is needed.
- 2) Ensure all providers are set up and ready to access the My Health Record
- 3) Collect baseline data from POLAR (see attached)
- 4) Implement ideas
- 5) Track changes in EMPHN POLAR Practice Report or via POLAR




