Safer Opioid Prescribing – Online and face-to-face workshops

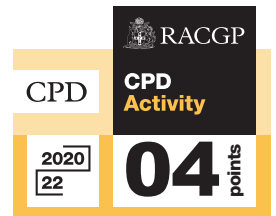
