After-hours GP services to RACFs

Currently, RACFs within the Yarra Ranges Local Government Area have the option of contacting Doctor Doctor to provide priority after hours GP services during the week from 6-10pm and on weekends from 2-6pm.

From 1 August, this priority service will no longer be available

RACFs can now utilise the following services:

- 1. Contact the residents regular GP to see if they are available to see their client
- 2. My Emergency Doctor (MED)

My Emergency Doctor is a specialist emergency Doctor available by phone or by downloading the My Emergency App. This service is free to all residents and RACFs in the Shire of Yarra Ranges and offers an Emergency Doctor on the line or via an App. Doctors are qualified and trained to quickly diagnose and treat patients. MED Doctors can prescribe and complete referrals, imaging and pathology requests which are emailed to the facility. A copy of the Clinical Summary is sent to the Clients regular GP following the consultation.

- On-site assessments by a Geriatric medicine register : Mon –Friday 9am-4.30pm
