Psychological Strategies (formerly known as ATAPS) – Bushfire and Post-Traumatic Stress Service

What is the Bushfire and Post-Traumatic Stress Service

Eastern Melbourne PHN's (EMPHN) Bushfire and Post-Traumatic Stress Service is a medium-term service for people with mild to moderate mental health issues.

The Bushfire and Post-Traumatic Stress Service offers:

- medium term support (24 individual sessions);
- focused psychological strategies; and
- up to 12 group sessions in addition.

This service is provided free of charge.

Who is this service for?

To be eligible for referral to the Bushfire and Post-Traumatic Stress Service, your patient must meet the following criteria:

- be aged 12 or older;
- have a mental health diagnosis;
- be affected by the Victorian bushfires or living in a bushfire affected area;
- cannot afford full fee counselling or a service gap fee for MBS Better Access subsidised counselling; and
- have not used the Medicare Benefits Schedule Better Access program in the current calendar year.

How to access the Bushfire and Post-Traumatic Stress Service

- Book a long consultation with your patient to discuss their wellbeing concerns.
- Develop a mental health treatment plan (MHTP).

- Complete an EMPHN Mental Health Services Referral Form and the Kessler Psychological Distress Scale (K10).
- Fax the MHTP, referral form and K10 to EMPHN's secure fax number on 8677 9510.
- Once processed, EMPHN will allocate your referral to a clinician in the community who will contact your patient for an appointment time.

What happens next?

- After the initial 12 sessions, you will be provided with a treatment review, indicating if additional sessions are required.
- If further sessions are required, please complete a referral form for a second set of sessions and MHTP review and fax these to the secure fax number.
- In exceptional circumstances a further six sessions can be accessed (consultation with the EMPHN intake team and an additional MHTP review is required).
