"Is this a routine appointment, or are you unwell today?"

ROUTINE

No fever, no sore throat, no cough, no shortness of breath or other respiratory infection signs, including mild symptoms

UNWELL

Any: fever, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath or other respiratory infection signs, including mild symptoms?

Have you travelled recently OR had contact with a confirmed or suspected case of coronavirus OR believe you may have been in infected?

TELEHEALTH/TELEPHONE CONSULTATION

Regular patients only (must have been seen by GP in last 12 months)

Must meet one of following Medicare criteria: pregnant, aged 70+, aged 50+ AND of ATSI descent, parent of child under 12 months, patient OR treating GP is immunocompromised or being treated for a chronic condition.

PATIENT WISHES TO BE EXAMINED BY A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL

Must meet the following criteria:

International travel in the 14 days prior to onset of illness OR close or casual contact in the 14 days prior to illness with

a confirmed case

AND fever OR acute respiratory infection
(+Pneumonia with no other cause identified or pneumonia
in a healthcare worker)
