Practice support

Participating general practices will receive:

- Incentive payment of \$2000 (GST exclusive)

What is required of participating general practices?

Two staff from each practice will be asked to attend one virtual orientation session and four virtual workshops via webinar. These workshops will help practices to decide on what changes they want to implement in between workshops. Practices will be supported along the way by the EMPHN team to implement and measure the impact of changes made.
