Did you know?

- Deaths from pharmaceutical drug overdose exceed the Road Toll¹
- Pharmaceutical drugs were involved in 372 drug deaths in 2016²
- Overdose deaths from prescription opioids exceed deaths from illegal drugs²
- Oxycodone is the 4th leading drug prescribed in general practice³
- There are changes to regulations for treating opioid addiction

All GPs can prescribe buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone[®]) for up to 5 patients. Case load is contained by the limit on patient numbers. This program discusses the who, what, why and how.
