Did you know?

- deaths from pharmaceutical drug overdose exceed the Road Toll¹
- pharmaceutical drugs were involved in 414 drug deaths in 2017²
- overdose deaths from prescription opioids exceed death from illegal drugs²
- there are changes to regulations for treating opioid addiction?

All GPs can prescribe buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone®) for up to 5 patients. Case load is contained by the limit on patient numbers. This program discusses the who, what, why and how.
