Am I eligible to participate in the study?

You are eligible if you are a health professional working in any setting, or you work in a RAS, ACAT or NDIS role where you help people with dementia access services.

Why should I take part in this study?

- Gain access to dementia-specific rehabilitation education that may enhance the care, wellbeing and quality of life for people with dementia and their care partners.

What will it involve?

- Participating in a self-paced 'Introduction to dementia rehabilitation' e-course (~6 hours over 4 weeks) commencing in July 2024.
- Complete two online surveys before and after the e-course.
