The RACGP Specific Interests Addiction Medicine Network together with RACGP Victoria invites you to partake in a one-day active learning module (ALM) addressing drug-seeking behaviours.

This workshop focuses on pragmatic approaches that general practitioners (GPs) can utilise when seeing patients with drug and alcohol-related issues.

With a focus on common general practice presentations, this ALM will assist GPs with addressing issues such as stigma, behavioural change, clinical governance and boundary setting. This interactive workshop provides sessions in skill development through case discussions, role playing and the sharing of professional knowledge.

Learning outcomes

- Implement practice systems by having developed approaches to address drug-seeking behaviours and help ensure patient safety.
- Assess and manage patients with drug-seeking behaviours to encourage behaviour change.
- Develop a comprehensive assessment and management plan for treating patients with opioid dependency.
- Recognise and reduce the stigmatisation and barriers associated with drug and alcohol dependence issues.
