Physical health initiatives for mental health consumers

EMPHN is releasing a tender to the market on Friday 31 January 2020 for the provision of Preventative Health Initiatives for mental health consumers in the Eastern Melbourne PHN catchment.

RFT details

We are seeking responses from suitably qualified providers to deliver an innovative and integrated solution/s that addresses key preventative health service barriers for mental health consumers, particularly focusing on individuals with moderate to severe mental illness.

The integrated service response will encompass the five preventative health elements:

- breast cancer screening
- bowel cancer screening
- cervical cancer screening
- influenza immunisation
- smoking cessation.

It is anticipated that the service response will enhance integration between primary health care and mental health services and therefore must be tailored to the target cohort, with the inclusion of service types that are delivered in a flexible and seamlessly integrated way across the healthcare system.
