# Health assessment for people 75 years and over

## For practice nurses

A health assessment of an older person is an in-depth assessment of a patient aged 75 years and over. It provides a structured way of identifying health issues and conditions that are potentially preventable or amenable to interventions in order to improve health and/or quality of life. This session will cover eligibility criteria and claiming frequency of the MBS item number, assessment tools and referral pathways to improve the health and quality of life for this age group.
