Key Message

The revised *Policy for Maintenance Pharmacotherapy for Opioid Dependence* will take effect on September 1st 2016.

Pharmacotherapy providers are encouraged to read the revised policy and understand that the tightened guidelines deliver stronger, clearer, safer and additional advice on the provision of pharmacotherapies throughout Victoria. The revised policy reiterates that unsupervised take-away pharmacotherapy doses are highly dangerous and should be restricted to very stable and continuous dosing clients who genuinely need them.
