

Fellowship Preparation Course

Objective Structured Clinical Exam

This course will assist GPs preparing for the Objective Structured Clinical Exam (OSCE) of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP).

Presenters

She has been an RACGP OSCE examiner and GP Registrar Supervisor since 2007.
