Medication Assisted Treatment of Opioid Dependence (MATOD) training

This training will provide prescribers with the skills to better manage patients with **opioid dependence** and the accreditation to prescribe approved pharmacotherapies.

Overview

Opioid dependence is a growing public health concern affecting a wide variety of patients including users of illicit, prescription and over-the-counter opioids.

Pharmacotherapy such as buprenorphine/naloxone, buprenorphine and methadone are effective evidence-based treatments for opioid dependence.

To prescribe buprenorphine/naloxone for more than 5 patients or methadone for any patient, the following <u>free</u> two-part training is a requirement:

- Module 1 (Safer Opioid Prescribing) a two-hour online training approved for 4 Category 2 RACGP QI&CPD points for the 2017-2019 triennium. This training is a compulsory pre-requisite to attend Module 2. To access this module click here or contact maryan.valverde@racgp.org.au.
- Module 2 A one day face-to-face workshop approved for 40 Category 1 RACGP QI&CPD points for the 2017-2019 triennium. See below for upcoming session details.
