When making your call, make sure you have a stable internet or data connection and a bright light source.



Our after hours clerical staff will collect basic details before transferring you to a doctor.



We will send you a confidential clinical summary along with any prescription, referral and imaging request you may need.

### **FAQ**

Examples of cases that would benefit from our service include: Head injury, concussion, fainting, fevers, acute injuries, abdominal pain, vomiting, rashes and headache.

Our doctors are qualified emergency specialists, also known as FACEMS (or Fellows for the Australasian College of Emergency Medicine). They are trained to quickly diagnose and treat patients.

This service does not replace your GP. Your GP is your primary healthcare provider but we will be there after hours when you're GP can't be.

#### Does it cost anything to use?

The service is free for eligible residents until the 31st of May 2019. Please refer to the list for accepted post code areas. For other callers this will be a paid service.

#### What are the after hours?

Outside 8am - 6pm on weekdays, outside 8am - 12 noon on Saturdays and all day on Sundays and public holidays.



If the patient is unconscious, has chest pain, difficulty breathing, uncontrolled bleeding or has been in a major accident, please dial 000.
