- Child Mental Health (CMH) Service

What is the Child Mental Health Service?

Eastern Melbourne PHN's (EMPHN) Child Mental Health (CMH) Service is a short-term service for children and their families.

The CMH service offers:

- brief support (12 individual sessions);
- focused psychological strategies;
- · parenting and family support work; and
- up to 12 group sessions in addition.

This service is provided free of charge.

Who is this service for?

To be eligible for referral to the CMH service, your child mist meet the following criteria:

- be aged between 0-11 at the time of the referral;
- have a mental health diagnosis or be at risk of developing a mental health diagnosis;
- family cannot afford full fee counselling or a service gap fee for MBS Better Access subsidised counselling; and
- have not used the Medicare Benefits Schedule Better Access program in the current calendar year.

How to access the CMH service

- Book a long consultation with your GP to discuss your child's wellbeing concerns.
- Your GP will then develop a mental health treatment plan (MHTP) and complete EMPHN's referral form and the Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ). Your GP will then send these to our secure fax number.
- Once processed EMPHN will allocate your referral to a clinician in the community who will contact you for an appointment time.
