Managing OTC Codeine requests: Treatment options for Codeine dependent patients; how to engage when identified as dependent; where to refer for comprehensive care. Case studies & group discussion.

Complex ORT patients: when and where to refer; comorbidities; drug interactions. Case studies & group discussion.

Pain Management: changing evidence about management of chronic pain; managing pain in ORT or addicted patients. Case

**Naloxone:** Guidelines and counselling points. Case studies & group discussion.

Managing challenging behaviours in the pharmacy: de-escalation of aggression; communication strategies. Case studies & group discussion.
