- **GPs are front-line Schedule 8 prescribers**
- Schedule 8 drugs of dependence have valued therapeutic uses
- Legislative requirements recognize the higher risk of misuse, abuse, and potential for dependence
- Schedule 8 Permit and Notification system is in place to manage risks, but knowledge gaps and confusion for GPs has been identified by the Drugs and Poisons Unit and Medical Indemnity organisations.
