

Suicide and Suicide Prevention: the community response

"What can we learn from the
community's experience?"



Eastern Melbourne PHN and Eastern Health are holding a community event to learn from people who have been impacted by suicide. What we learn from this conversation will be used in our work to improve how the health system prevents suicide and supports those impacted by it.

The Commonwealth and Victorian State Government have committed to improving support for people impacted by suicide; Eastern Melbourne PHN and Eastern Health are working together to identify how we might improve the service system, and improve care for people within our community.

At this event, we want to talk with people in the Maroondah area who have been impacted by suicide. We want to hear about the kinds of support they have received, what worked, and what could have been done better.

What we learn from this conversation will be used in our work to design better ways to prevent possible suicide and to support those who may be impacted.

How might we support efforts to reach people in need before a crisis?
