What is Walrus?

Walrus is a point of care support tool for GPs and nurses that prompts about missing data, missing measures and missing Chronic Disease and Health Assessments MBS items. It is fully customisable with users having the option of deciding which prompts/notifications they want displayed and can be adjusted to suit needs.


It is free to download for any practice currently using POLAR.
