Aim of Activity *

The aim of psychosocial access enablers is to improve the interface and strengthen delivery of the psychosocial support program.

Description of Activity *

Please note that budget values provided in brackets against each sub-activity heading is for FY24/25.

- Service navigation (including housing connections) (\$185,296))
- Conduct a housing needs assessment to establish insights into how to improve access to and stability of housing for people with a mental health illness in the EMPHN catchment. It will detail services available and identify gaps for the community and support

commissioned providers in engaging with housing and homeless services. This housing support is embedded into the psychosocial program of commissioned providers.

- EMPHN SupportConnect service and commissioned psychosocial service providers working together to ensure there are no gaps in service delivery for those consumers with psychosocial issues.
- One commissioned provider has embedded a specific role to delivery service navigation activities including support consumers to access other supports outside CSP and redirect referrals into appropriate support who are not eligible for CPS or are waiting for services. The provider has budgeted \$108,820 for this role.
- Psychosocial Networking to coordinate with local area coordinators, lived experience community members, LHNs and commissioned psychosocial service providers to discuss pathways to care.
- NDIS testing support (\$171,830)

Support psychosocial service providers to enable them to support participants who may be eligible to apply or re-apply for funding under the NDIS. Commissioned providers support eligible consumers to test, or retest for NDIS through coordination and liaison with medical and other suitable qualified staff. Providers may use limited amount of brokerage to purchase Psychiatric assessment for documentation requirements if required. The use of capacity and strengths base tools to help identify NDIS support needs. Associated funding is rolled into commissioned contracts.

• Capacity and strengths-based assessments (\$5,690.00)

Commissioned providers are using one of two capacity and strengths base assessment tools. The Recovery Star and Recovery Assessment Scale - Domains and Stages (RAS-DS) where deemed appropriate to identify and facilitate psychosocial support needs of consumers. All CPS workers have been training in use of one of the relevant tools.

• Regional Loading (\$3,066.00)

Any Regional loading is insignificant and therefore rolled into the commissioned contracts to support outreach delivery cost across the outer area of the EMPHN Catchment.

• PHN Operational (\$266,450.00)

Operational funding is used for commissioning support functions including a contact management staff with oversight of the commissioned services and associated service delivery enabler activities and EMPHN Support Connect.

Description of Activity *

EMPHN will continue to commission two providers to deliver services to people with a mental illness requiring psychosocial support services. Providers will deliver services that support consumers to:

- receive practical help (daily living/tasks)
- be supported (mental health, physical health, housing, education, work leisure etc.)
- be better connected with others, including family, friends, peers, community, mainstream supports and other services.

Services have a recovery focus and are trauma informed. Participants are supported to apply for the NDIS if their needs meet the criteria for a NDIS application.
