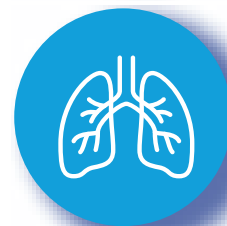


# Introducing the New Lung Cancer Screening Pathway on HealthPathways
