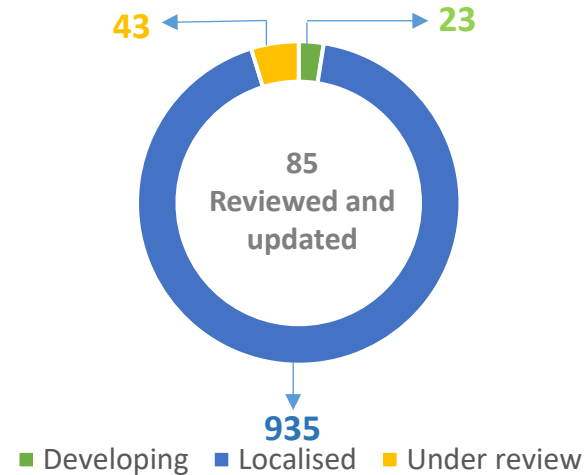

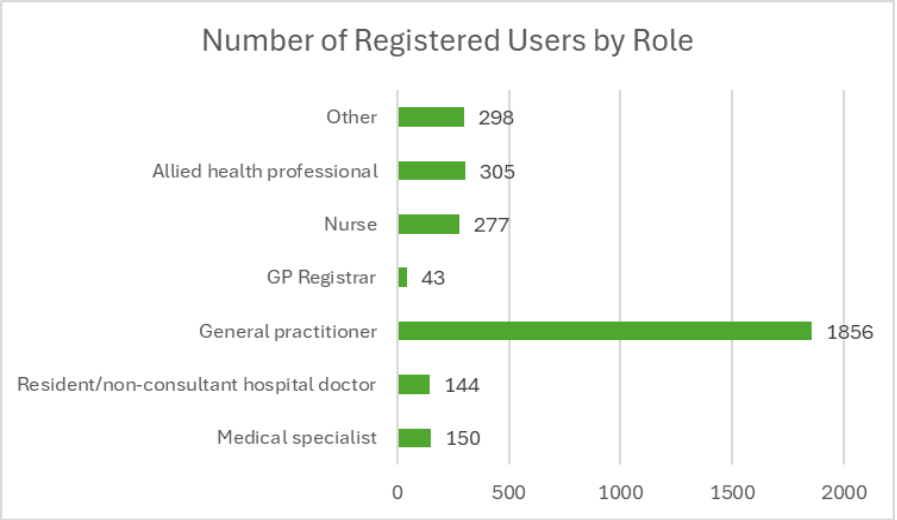
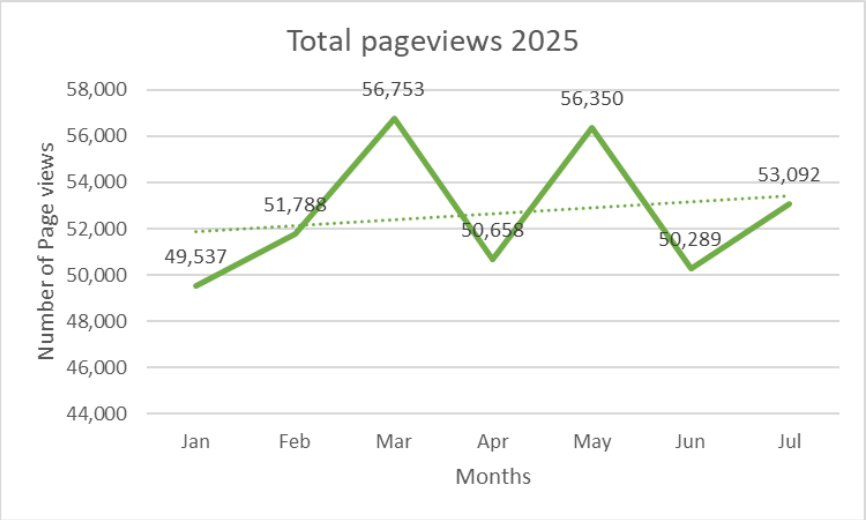

- PCOS (114 views) and Menopause (86 views) also showed strong interest.



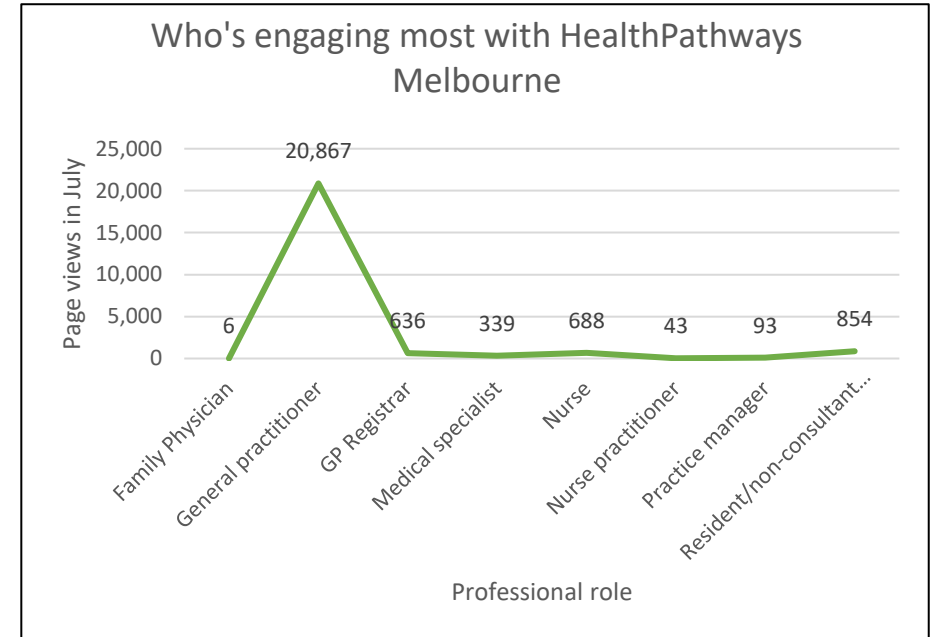
## Practice Nurses and Managers
