



## **Pathways and Engagement Statistics**

#### **Top Searches & Most Viewed Pathways**



- > Hypertension and PCOS remain dominant, appearing in both top searches and most viewed pathways.
- The most viewed clinical pathways were Antenatal Care and Hypertension.
- ➤ Women's health topics maintain solid engagement, with PCOS (181), Recurrent UTIs in Women (151), and Menopause Hormone Therapy (MHT) (145) among the top GP-viewed pages.
- November saw decrease in total pageviews compared to October, likely reflecting a seasonal endof-year slowdown.

#### GP Engagement



- >With 2,123 registered users, GPs remain the largest and most active group, underscoring strong engagement across primary care.
- Engagement is rising, with notable gains among Nurses (+22) and Allied Health (+14). This growth shows strong multidisciplinary collaboration, likely supported by recent North Western Melbourne and Eastern Melbourne PHN Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) initiatives.
- The top viewed pages by GPs were Antenatal Care-First Consult (312 views) Hypertension (212 views) Abnormal Liver Function Tests (211 views) Headaches in Adults(205 views) highlighting a strong focus on antenatal care, chronic conditions, and diagnostic guidance. These four pathways have consistently remained among the most accessed GP pages over recent months.

#### **Practice Nurses and Managers**




- ➤ Practice Managers: Increased activity on GP Mental Health Treatment Plan (MHTP) pathway. This growth is likely influenced by sector changes, the introduction of this pathway and targeted promotions (MHTP in HealthPathways November Bulletin).
- ➤ Practice Nurses: Higher engagement on COVID-19, Immunisation-Adults and Intravenous Iron Infusion pathways, highlighting continued interest in preventive and acute care topics.

### **Key Clinical Focus Areas**



- > Hypertension remains a consistent area of interest, appearing as both the top search term and one of the most viewed pathways, indicating its continued relevance.
- Women's health topics continues to be prominent such as Antenatal Care, PCOS, Recurrent UTIs and Menopause Harmone therapy.
- Diagnostic navigation is strong, with Abnormal LFTs and Headaches in Adults among the most consulted pathways.



General Practitioners were the most active users on HealthPathways Melbourne in August, accounting for over 19,000 page views
