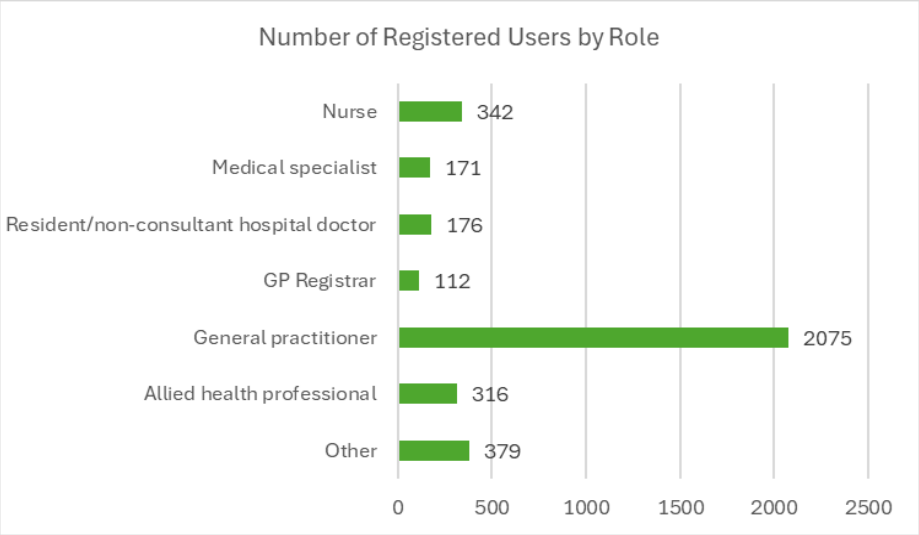
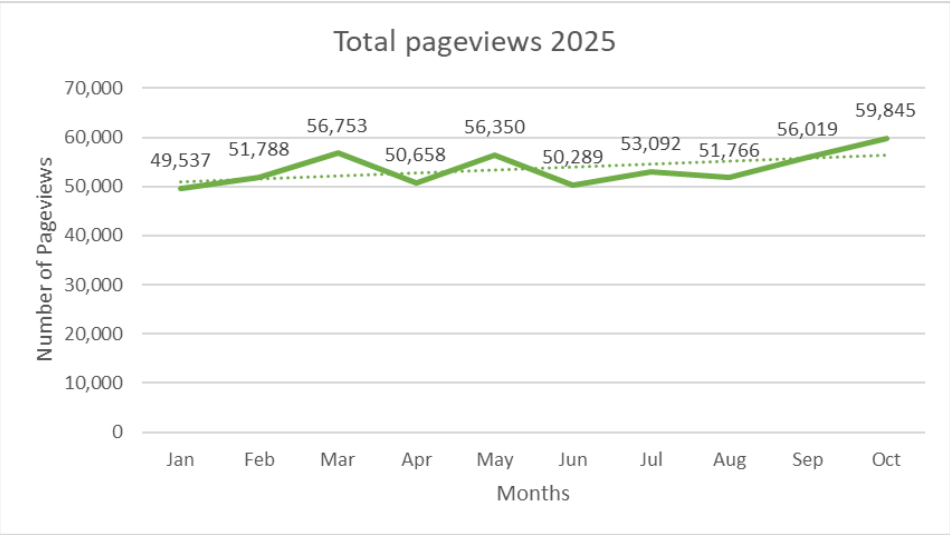

# Pathways and Engagement Statistics



## Top Searches & Most Viewed Pathways

- Hypertension and PCOS remain dominant, appearing in both top searches and most viewed pathways.
- The most viewed clinical pathways were Antenatal Care and Abnormal Liver Function Tests.
- Gout (120 views) and Osteoporosis(119 views), have emerged among the top search terms, highlighting growing interest in chronic conditions.
- Menopause (115 views) continues steady engagement, reinforcing women's health focus.
- Total Pageviews (59,845) continuing the upward trend from previous month (56,019)



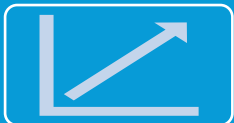
## GP Engagement

- GP registrations grew by 76, with strong gains in Nurses (+28), Allied Health (+45), and Medical Specialists (+8). Overall, growth reflects increasing engagement across diverse roles.
- The top viewed pages by GPs were Antenatal Care-First Consult ( 352 views) Abnormal Liver Function Tests (294 views) Hypertension (225 views) Headaches in Adults(220 views) and Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome (185 views) highlighting a strong focus on antenatal care, chronic conditions, and diagnostic guidance.
- There are 2,075 general practitioners registered, representing the largest user group and highlighting strong engagement from primary care clinicians.



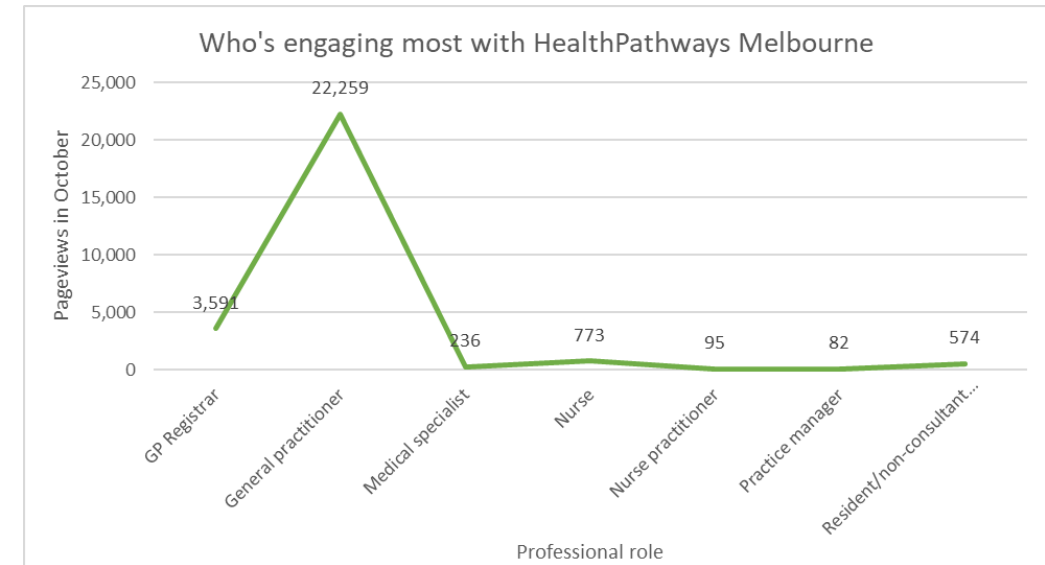
## Practice Nurses and Managers

- Pathways on COVID-19, Menopause and Hypothyroidism saw increased activity from Practice manager. Iron Deficiency Anaemia, Recurrent UTIs in Women and Older Adult's Health saw increased activity from Practice Nurses.



## Key Clinical Focus Areas

- Hypertension remains a consistent area of interest, appearing as both the top search term and one of the most viewed pathways, indicating its continued relevance.
- Women's health topics such as Antenatal Care and PCOS remain highly engaged.
- Menopause remains a steady area of interest amongst GPs, with 112 searches and the Menopause Hormone therapy pathway appearing among the top viewed pages (140 views), underscoring it's continued relevance in women's health
