

POLAR Walkthrough - Identify patients at risk of dementia

Step 1


Open POLAR and from Reports Select Clinic Summary Report


Step 2

Select the Quick Filter RACGP& Practice Active patients shortcut on the top left hand side.




Step 3

Using the filters on the left hand side select Risk Categories then select Dementia Risk, select yes and confirm your selection.



Step 4

You can now select the patient list or identify if the patients are eligible for any chronic disease items or health assessments using the tracked MBS report under MBS



Notes

Patient Eligibility: To be included as having a Dementia Risk, the patient needs to be:

- Age >= 40
- RACGP Active
- Clinic Active
 No active Dementia/Alzheimer's diagnosis

Risk Profile: Depending on the patient's age and indigenous status, a combination of these factors will trigger the Dementia Prompt:

- Smoking Status = Smoker

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 Alcohol Consumption = 43+ drinks per week
 Diabetes Type 1 (Active or Inactive) OR Type 2
 diagnosis (Active Only)
 Active Diagnosis = Depression OR Atrial
 fibrillation OR Stroke OR Hypertension OR Insomnia OR Traumatic Brain Injury
