ABOUT THE SESSIONS

As part of the **BridgePoint Project**, we’re launching a monthly series of **30-minute online information sessions** to showcase the rich expertise and diverse roles of services across the **North East Mental Health Service Coordination Alliance (NEMHSCA)**.

These short, focused sessions are designed to build understanding, foster collaboration, and make it easier for clinicians, team leaders, and lived and living experience workers to **connect across services** and better support consumers with co-occurring mental health and substance use needs.

SESSION FORMAT

- **15-minute Q&A** – Ask questions, clarify referral processes, and explore opportunities to collaborate.
- **Monthly, via Teams**
- Showcasing a **different service each month** from the mental health, AOD, or related sectors
