


Top Searches & Most Viewed Pathways



- December recorded 50,113 total views, a +744 increase on November, and consistent with the average monthly views for the year.
- UTI rose to the #1 search term (+24, +23.5%), while Hypertension dropped to #2 (-22, -15.6%). Asthma saw strong growth (+19, +20.4%), New topics entering the top 10 include Shingles, Diabetes and Haematuria.
- The increased search interest in UTI is mirrored in pathway engagement, where Recurrent UTIs in Women ranked among the top 20 GP pages viewed. Antenatal Care – First Consult stayed the top GP pathway, with continued strong use of Abnormal LFTs, Hypertension, Headaches in Adults and PCOS, highlighting steady demand for diagnostic, chronic disease and women's health guidance.

GP Engagement



- With 2,150 registered users, GPs remain the largest and most active group, underscoring strong engagement across primary care.
- GP usage continues to centre on Antenatal Care-First Consult (280 views) Abnormal Liver Function Tests (254 views), Hypertension (181 views), Headaches in Adults(178 views) mirroring November's trends and reinforcing the consistent clinical value of these core primary-care topics.
- GP pageviews remained steady in December, showing only a slight decline from November and reflecting typical year-end seasonal slowdowns while still maintaining sustained engagement across core clinical pathways.

Practice Nurses and Managers




- Practice Managers: Increased activity on Guide to MBS pathway.
- Practice Nurses: Higher engagement on Dermatology, Investigations and Immunisation –Travel pathway highlighting continued interest in preventive and acute care topics.
- Immunisation – Travel engagement is elevated, consistent with summer/holiday travel demand.

Key Clinical Focus Areas



- UTI was the top search term in December, and this was reflected in continued use of the Recurrent UTIs in Women pathway. Hypertension was the second most searched term and remained frequently accessed, showing engagement across both infection and chronic disease areas.
- Women's health topics continues to be prominent such as Antenatal Care and PCOS.
- Diagnostic navigation pathways such as Abnormal LFTs and Headaches in Adults continued to be among the most viewed, and both pathways regularly appeared in the top five pathways throughout the year.

Who's engaging most with HealthPathways Melbourne



General Practitioners were the most active users on HealthPathways Melbourne in August, accounting for over 18,400 page views
