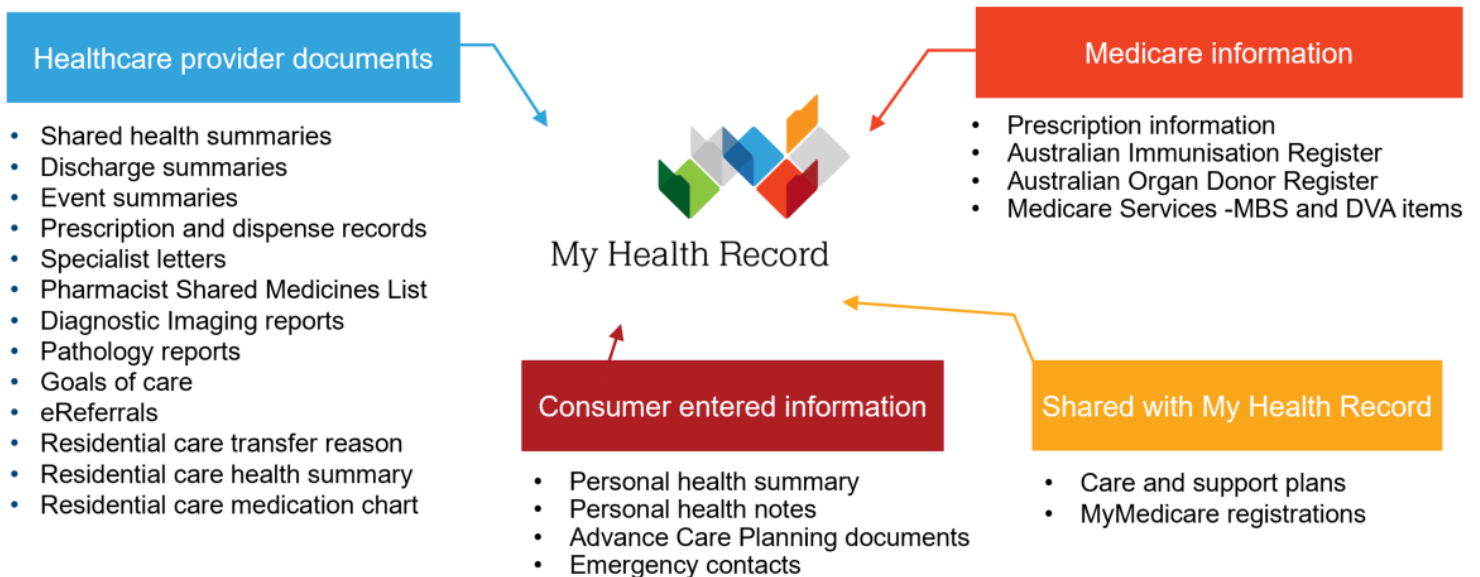


My Health Record

Healthcare provider benefits

- Provides immediate access to key health information.
- Facilitates the validation and verification of clinical information.
- Reduces adverse medication events, provides access to allergy information.
- Reduces duplication of tests and diagnostic imaging.
- Provides immunisation details.
- Improves continuity of care and can inform end of life care.



Accessing My Health Record to view

Under the *My Health Records Act 2012*, staff members authorised by a healthcare organisation can access and view a patient’s record:

- for the purpose of providing that patient with healthcare, and
- provided it is in accordance with any access controls, and
- In addition to clinicians, a healthcare organisation may authorise other staff to access the system as part of their role in healthcare delivery.



My Health Record

Accessing My Health Record to upload

Staff can only author clinical information to upload to My Health Record if:

- they have a [Healthcare Provider Identifier – Individual \(HPI-I\)](#), and
- their registration authority, or membership of a professional association, is not conditional, suspended, cancelled or lapsed.

Note: A healthcare organisation can upload health information to a patient's My Health Record unless the patient has asked them not to, or the information is subject to a prescribed state or territory law and consent has not been obtained. ([My Health Records Act 2012](#)).

Who can author and upload documents in a healthcare organisation?



Shared health summary – Can only be authored by a nominated healthcare provider, namely a registered medical practitioner, a registered nurse, or an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander health practitioner with a Certificate IV in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care.



Discharge summary – A hospital can upload a discharge summary, as well as send it to the intended recipient as per current practices.



Pathology and diagnostic imaging reports – Can be uploaded by the registered pathology laboratory or imaging service. It can also be sent directly to the referring healthcare provider.



Event summary – Can be authored by any healthcare provider using conformant software provided they have a Healthcare Provider Identifier–Individual, and they are involved in that patient's care.



Prescription and dispense records – Can be uploaded by the healthcare provider that prescribed or dispensed the medication.



Pharmacist Shared Medicines List (PSML) – Can only be authored by a pharmacist

Specialist letters – Can be uploaded by the treating specialist



Goals of care/Advanced Care Plan – Can be uploaded by any healthcare provider

eReferrals – Uploaded by any healthcare provider involved in the patient's care with conformant software



Aged care transfer information – May be uploaded by any healthcare provider at an aged care facility.
