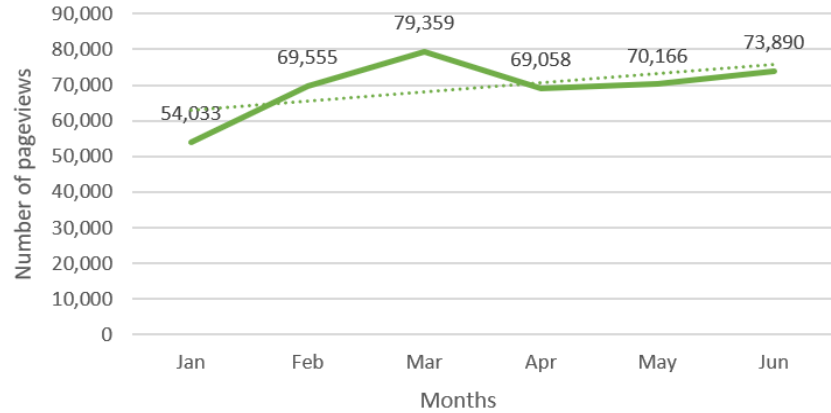

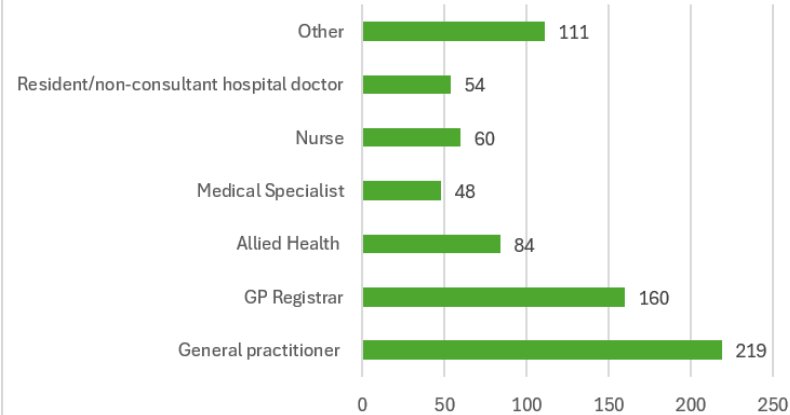

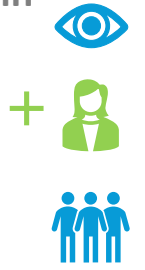
Number of Registered Users by Role

Top Searches & Most Viewed Pathways

- The most viewed clinical pathways were Antenatal Care, Abnormal Liver Function Tests and Hypertension.
- The most searched terms included Hypertension, Gout and UTI.
- The close alignment between search activity and pathway views suggests clinicians are successfully finding and accessing relevant clinical guidance through HealthPathways Melbourne.



GP Engagement

- In the 6-month period (Jan-June 2026), 219 GPs gained access to the HealthPathways Melbourne site, representing the largest group of users (by Professional role), followed by GP registrars at 160.
- The top pages viewed by GPs were Antenatal Care, Abnormal Liver Function Tests, Hypertension, PMOS and Headaches in Adults.



Practice Nurses and Managers

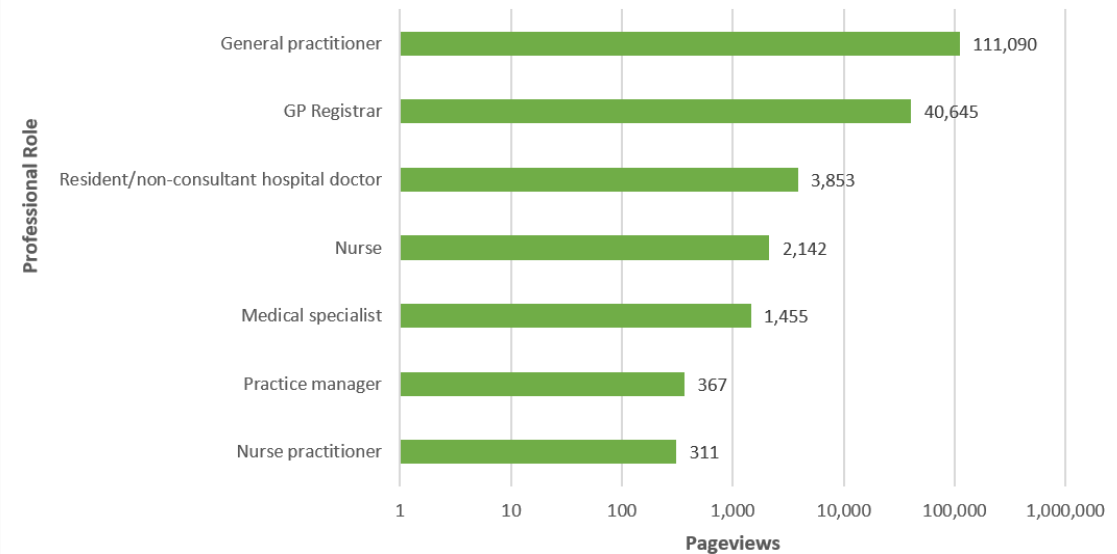
- Practice Nurses showed strong engagement with pathways relating to older adults' health, child health, diabetes management and palliative care.
- Practice Managers most frequently accessed referral and practice support resources, highlighting the role of HealthPathways in supporting service navigation and practice operations



Key Clinical Focus Areas

- Women's health remains a prominent area of engagement, with Antenatal Care recording the highest number of pathway views and PMOS appearing among both the top search terms and most viewed pathways
- Hypertension remained a key area of interest, ranking as the most searched term and one of the most viewed clinical pathways during the reporting period.

Who's engaged most with HealthPathways Melbourne



General Practitioners remain to be the core audience and the most active users on HealthPathways Melbourne From January-June 2026, accounting for over 111,000 page views followed by GP Registrars with 40,645 page views. Engagement was also recorded across nurses, medical specialists, practice managers and hospital-based clinicians, demonstrating the platform's value as a shared resource for clinical guidance and referral support across the healthcare workforce, beyond primary care. The high GP Registrar share suggests the platform is embedding into early-career workflows, which bodes well for long-term retention.
